# Tim Quick's Presentation About 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Registration

Requirements for graduation: 54 credits, 35 of which are required (there is space in the schedule for 64 credits), passing grades in all required classes, completion of all required assessments (ACT, MCA, etc).

The schedule at the HS is a four-period day with four terms per year.

Required in 9<sup>th</sup> grade: social studies, science, Englsh, math plus electives. 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades must register for 16 credits.

When choosing classes, consider things like current class levels/performance, academic interests, and college requirements if known. Don't take a class just because a friend is taking it or it's rumored to have a great teacher or easy grading – have a plan.

There is an open house for parents and students on January 31. Registration begins online February 1 and closes February 11. There will be a hotline for questions at 952-975-8333 February 5 and 7 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Vanessa Plopper's Breakout Box Presentation

In Impact, students take a series of assessments to learn about themselves. They also read a passage and watch a TED talk about dyslexia. A popular activity with students uses "breakout boxes", which are boxes with several different types of combination locks securing them. Students work together to figure out the combination to each of the locks from a series of clues given to them. Once all of the locks are opened, students are surprised to find small treats as rewards in the boxes. PTO participated in this activity on two teams and all involved thought the activity would be a fun and successful way to reinforce the 4C's with students.
